Here is an outline for 6 fantastic photo days. Note that we start at the photo basics but each day will progressively offer greater challenges. This suits everyone at all levels.

A GREAT FUN PACKED WEEK ...

DAY 1 - Sunday, March 16

Meet at the resort at 2pm and a 2 hour workshop to help you get the most from your stay on beautiful Kangaroo Island.

DAY 2 - Monday, March 17

Early morning departure to Flinders Chase NP to shoot the Remarkable Rocks.
Return to lodge for lunch (package only) workshop to follow up this mornings shoot and to cover digital techniques further. Late afternoon shoot at Admirals Arch and sunset with the lighthouse.

DAY 3 - Tuesday, March 18

Early departure for Seal Bay Conservation Park. This area offers excellent wildlife images of Australian Sea Lions. Shoot time is limited due to park rules. A small entrance fee applies. We then drive onto Kingscote and an afternoon of opportunity. Pelicans are famous here. The drive around the island will open up other images to shoot.

DAY 4 - Wednesday, March 19

Morning workshop on macro, creative and other points of interest. The local lodge offers great birds, wallabies, flowers and creative opportunities.
After lunch - we head again into Flinders Chase for another afternoon shoot. You can not get enough of this great location.

DAY 5 - Thursday, March 20

Early morning departure to Flinders Chase NP to shoot the Remarkable Rocks. This special location will offer you new and great images. We head back to explore around the parks headquarters and have lunch. (not included)
The rest of the afternoon is free to relax or explore. Your tutor will offer suggestions. Perhaps you are interested to shoot some near by koalas?

DAY 6 - Friday, March 21

Morning shoot subject to your tutor.
You return to the lodge and a final chance to ask questions. Event finishes at 12pm.
